LEAVERS' GATHERING

On Tuesday 26th July we will be holding our Leavers' Gathering in the school hall. This is always a well-attended event and gives our Year 6 class the opportunity to share memories of their time at St. Charles' with all members of our school community. As it is such an important gathering for the parents of our leavers, we will be having a VIP entrance this year for them. FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

The Government have given approval to the issuing of Free School Meal vouchers over the summer holidays. These vouchers will be issued when we finish for the school holidays and will be a one-off payment to cover the summer holidays. The vouchers can be used in smaller amounts. **The vouchers should not be redeemed for any age-restricted items, such as alcohol, cigarettes or lottery tickets.**

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Following the school uniform consultation on PE kits, our school uniform list has now been updated to include Red hoodies, grey jogging bottoms or leggings and trainers. It is not necessary to have branded items of uniform. Plain jumpers and t-shirts from supermarkets are a cheaper alternative and recommended due to how quickly children grow and how uniform gets damaged through everyday wear and tear. However, for those parents who wish to purchase branded hoodies, Whittakers will have them in stock shortly.

Your child's class teacher will contact you when we return to inform you about what days your child's class will have their PE lessons.

DROWNING PREVENTION – STAY SAFE NEAR WATER (MESSAGE FROM LANCASHIRE FIRE AND RESCUE)

Following the recent tragic drowning incident involving a 16-year-old at Dawber Delph at Appley Bridge, schools have been asked to share the following message:

When the warm weather hits, please don't be tempted to cool off in open water -

- The water is colder than it looks, even on a warm evening
- This can lead to cold water shock
- The current is stronger than it looks
- There are hidden dangers beneath the surface

If you see someone in trouble in the water:

- call 999;
- encourage them not to panic;
- and, if they can't stand, float on their back in a starfish shape.

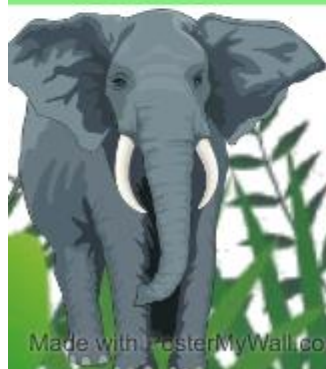
