SCHOOL IS CONTINUING TO OPERATE AT OUR COVID-19 AMBER LEVEL

Unfortunately, we have had to move 3 more classes to our Amber Level this week due to positive cases of Covid-19. We currently have 7 members of our school community who have tested positive. As always, I am monitoring the situation and the data very carefully and liaising with my Senior Leadership Team to ensure we have appropriate measures in place to try to prevent any wider spread of Covid-19 around school. If the measures have been effective, we hope that most of these classes can return to our Green Level early next week. I'm sure you will all join me in sending prayers to all affected and hope they are well enough to return at the end of their isolation period.

This week's Gospel is one we are all familiar with as it is the wedding in Cana where Jesus changed water into wine. During the week, the children will explore this story and begin to understand why Jesus turned the water into wine and what he was wanting to show to everybody.



COVID-19 UPDATE

There are changes to the isolation guidance coming into effect from next week. The guidance states that:

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be [reported to NHS Test and Trace](#).

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.
